### *County Rate*

#### **152 Liability of certain quarter sessions boroughs to other county expenses.**

- (1) If the whole or any part of the area for the time being comprised in a borough having a separate court of quarter sessions was, before the eleventh of July one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two, chargeable with or liable to contribute to the county rate of the county in which it is situate, the municipal corporation shall, . . . <sup>F1</sup> continue liable to contribute to the county rate for other purposes (in this Act referred to as general county purposes), as if this Act had not been passed.
- (2) General county purposes shall not include the costs arising out of coroners' inquests, or the expenses incurred under the <sup>M1</sup>Sale of Food and Drugs Act, 1875, in respect of the county, . . . <sup>F2</sup>, or payments to or in respect of special constables.
