

Naval Pensions Act 1884

1884 CHAPTER 44 47 and 48 Vict

Application to Greenwich Hospital pensions of 28 & 29 Vict. cc. 73, 111, 124.

Any reference in the ^{M1}Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act, 1865, the ^{M2}Navy and Marines (Property of Deceased) Act, 1865 [^{F1}or section 356 of the Armed Forces Act 2006] . . . ^{F2}, to a pension or a naval pension, or to money payable by the Admiralty, shall be construed to include a naval pension and a Greenwich Hospital pension, gratuity, and allowance, within the meaning of the Greenwich Hospital Acts, 1865 to 1883, and any sum due on account of such a pension, gratuity, or allowance.
