280 Delivery up of certificate.

- (1) The Board of Trade may require a passenger steamer's certificate, which has expired or been cancelled, to be delivered up as they direct.
- (2) If any owner or master fails without reasonable cause to comply with such requirement, he shall for each offence be liable to a fine not exceeding [F12[F13£50]][F12]evel 2 on the standard scale].

- (2) If the owner or master fails without reasonable cause to comply with this section, he shall for each offence be liable to a fine not exceeding [F14[F15£50]][F14] level 2 on the standard scale].
- (3) If a passenger steamer plies or goes to sea with passengers on board, and this section is not complied with, then for each offence the owner thereof shall be liable to a fine not exceeding [F16[F17£200]][F16]evel 4 on the standard scale], and the master shall also be liable to a further fine not exceeding [F16[F17£200]][F16]evel 4 on the standard scale].
