280 Delivery up of certificate.

- (1) The Board of Trade may require a passenger steamer’s certificate, which has expired or been cancelled, to be delivered up as they direct.
- (2) If any owner or master fails without reasonable cause to comply with such requirement, he shall for each offence be liable to a fine not exceeding [^{F12}[^{F13}£50]][^{F12}level 2 on the standard scale].

281 Posting up of certificate.

- (1) The owner or master of every passenger steamer required to have a passenger steamer’s certificate shall forthwith on the receipt of the certificate by him or his agent

- (2) If the owner or master fails without reasonable cause to comply with this section, he shall for each offence be liable to a fine not exceeding [^{F14}£50][^{F14}level 2 on the standard scale].
- (3) If a passenger steamer plies or goes to sea with passengers on board, and this section is not complied with, then for each offence the owner thereof shall be liable to a fine not exceeding [^{F16}£200][^{F16}level 4 on the standard scale], and the master shall also be liable to a further fine not exceeding [^{F16}£200][^{F16}level 4 on the standard scale].
