2. PASSENGER STEAMERS

Survey of Passenger Steamers

280 Delivery up of certificate.

- (1) The Board of Trade may require a passenger steamer's certificate, which has expired or been cancelled, to be delivered up as they direct.
- (2) If any owner or master fails without reasonable cause to comply with such requirement, he shall for each offence be liable to a fine not exceeding [^{F1}£50]^{F2} level 2 on the standard scale].
