### 1 Power to cancel bailiffs' certificates.

A certificate granted to a bailiff by  $[^{F1}$  a judge of the county court ] under the  $^{M1}$ Law of Distress Amendment Act 1888, may at any time be cancelled or declared void by a judge of  $[^{F2}$ the county court ], . . .  $^{F3}$
