1 Power to cancel bailiffs' certificates.

A certificate granted to a bailiff by [^{F1} a judge of the county court] under the ^{M1}Law of Distress Amendment Act 1888, may at any time be cancelled or declared void by a judge of [^{F2} the county court], . . . ^{F3}
