



# Cleansing of Persons Act 1897

1897 CHAPTER 31 60 and 61 Vict

## 3 Application to Scotland.

In the application of this Act to Scotland, “local authority” means and includes any local authority under the <sup>M1</sup>[<sup>F1</sup>Public Health (Scotland) Act 1897], and any Acts amending that Act; but the local authority shall not erect buildings for the purposes of section one hereof, except with the sanction of the [<sup>F2</sup>Secretary of State].
