

Cleansing of Persons Act 1897

1897 CHAPTER 31 60 and 61 Vict

3 Application to Scotland.

In the application of this Act to Scotland, "local authority" means and includes any local authority under the ^{MI}[^{FI}Public Health (Scotland) Act 1897], and any Acts amending that Act; but the local authority shall not erect buildings for the purposes of section one hereof, except with the sanction of the [F2Secretary of State].
