1845 CHAPTER 17

Recovery of Damages and Penalties

CLVI Damage to be made good in addition to Penalty.

If, through any Act, Neglect, or Default on account whereof any Person shall have incurred any Penalty imposed by this or the special Act, or any Act incorporated therewith, any Damage to the Property of the Company shall have been committed by such Person, he shall be liable to make good such Damage, as well as to pay such Penalty ; and the Amount of such Damages shall, in case of Dispute, be determined by the Sheriff or Justices by whom the Party incurring such Penalty shall have been convicted ; and on Nonpayment of such Damages, on demand, the same shall be levied by Poinding and Sale, and such Sheriff or Justices shall issue his or their Warrant accordingly.
