## 1845 CHAPTER 18 8 and 9 Vict

### *Application of compensation*

#### **70 Order for application, and investment meanwhile.**

Such money may be so applied as aforesaid upon an order of the Court of Chancery . . .  
<sup>F1</sup> made on the petition of the party who would have been entitled to the rents and profits of the lands in respect of which such money shall have been deposited, [<sup>F2</sup>and if, before it is so applied, it is [<sup>F3</sup>invested under section 38 of the Administration of Justice Act 1982] the annual proceeds thereof shall be paid] to the party who would for the time being have been entitled to the rents and profits of the lands.
