

Land Clauses Consolidation Act 1845

1845 CHAPTER 18 8 and 9 Vict

Application of compensation

77 Upon deposit being made a receipt to be given, and the lands to vest upon a deed poll being executed.

Upon any [^{F1}such payment or deposit] of money as last aforesaid being made ^{F2} ... [^{F3}it shall be lawful for the promoters of the undertaking, if they think fit, to execute a deed poll, under their common seal if they be a corporation, or if they be not a corporation under the hands and seals of the said promoters, or any two of them [^{F3}then, if the promoters of the undertaking think fit, it shall be lawful for the promoters to execute a deed poll under their common seal if they are a corporation, or, if they are not a corporation, for the promoters or any two of them to execute a deed poll, containing a description of the lands in respect whereof [^{F1}such payment or deposit] shall have been made, and declaring the circumstances under which and the names of the parties to whose credit [^{F1}such payment or deposit] shall have been made, and such deed poll shall be stamped with the stamp duty which would have been payable upon a conveyance to the promoters of the undertaking of the lands described therein; and thereupon all the estate and interest in such lands of the parties for whose use and in respect whereof such purchase money or compensation shall have been [^{F1}paid or deposited] shall vest absolutely in the promoters of the undertaking, and as against such parties they shall be entitled to immediate possession of such lands.
