



# Railways Clauses Consolidation (Scotland) Act 1845

## *Construction of railway*

### **23 Penalty for obstructing supply of gas or water.**

If by any such operations as foresaid the company shall interrupt the supply of water or gas, they shall forfeit twenty pounds for every day that such supply shall be so interrupted; and such penalty shall be appropriated to [<sup>F1</sup>that fund of the local authority or water board to which their revenues in respect of water are appropriated or, in the case of an interruption of a supply of gas, shall be paid to the Area Gas Board.]
