5 Interpretation clause. U.K.

.....^{F1} In the construction of this Act.....^{F1} the word “highways” shall be understood to mean all roads, bridges . . .^{F2}, carriageways, cartways, horseways, bridleways, footways, causeways, churchways, and pavements; . . .^{F1}
