An Act for confirming Sales of Parts of an Estate called Garthmeilio, belonging to John Wynne Esquire, who has been found a Lunatic by Inquisition; and for authorizing the Sale of further Parts of the same Estate for the Purpose of paying Costs incurred in the Matter of his Lunacy, and certain of his private Debts.

[5th July 1865.]

HEREAS by an Inquisition by Edward Winslow Esquire, Inquisition One of the Masters in Lunacy, on the Fourth Day of dated 4th February One thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, in John Wynne. pursuance of an Order of the Lords Justices dated the Fifteenth Day declared a of January One thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, made, it Lunatic. was found that John Wynne was a Person of unsound Mind, so that he was not sufficient for the Government of himself and his Estates: And whereas by a Report in the Matter of the Lunacy, dated the Report Fifteenth Day of June One thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, dated 15th and duly confirmed, Master Winslow found, among other things, to [Private.] the

the Effect following; that is to say, that the Marriage of John Wynne with Phæbe Virginia his Wife was celebrated on the Fifteenth Day of April One thousand eight hundred and forty-six, and that there had been Four Children only the Issue of their Marriage, all of whom died under the Age of Eight Years, and that Caroline Sobieski Lynes, then the Widow of the Reverend John Lynes deceased, and Augusta Eliza Marshall, then the Widow of Admiral Sir John Marshall deceased, who both of them were the Sisters of John Wynne by the Half-Blood, were his Coheiresses at Law, and that they and Ann Wynne, the Mother of John Wynne, were his only Next of Kin, and were, together with Phæbe Virginia his Wife, the only Persons who would be entitled to the Estate of John Wynne or to Shares thereof under the Statutes for the Distribution of Intestates Estates in case he were then dead intestate; and that by virtue of the Will of Robert Watkin Wynne, the paternal Grandfather of John Wynne, and as Heir-at-Law of Robert Watkin Wynne, and by virtue of an Indenture of the Eleventh Day of October One thousand eight hundred and forty-eight, enrolled in Chancery, and by reason of the Failure of divers Limitations in the Will contained, John Wynne became on the Twenty-fifth Day of November One thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven and was then entitled in Fee Simple in Possession to the Garthmeilio Estate, subject, however, as therein-after appeared; and the Report stated divers other Matters from which it appears that by the enrolled Indenture of the Eleventh Day of October One thousand eight hundred and forty-eight the Garthmeilio Estate was assured by John Wynne to Alexander Bicknell and Thomas Dax in Base Fee by way of Mortgage thereof to them for securing Twelve thousand Pounds, and that by an Indenture of the Ninth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and forty-nine he further charged the Garthmeilio Estate with the Payment to them of Two thousand Pounds, and that by a Post-Nuptial Settlement, also of the Ninth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, John Wynne settled the Garthmeilio Estate, subject to the then preceding Life Estates therein, and to the Mortgage and further Charge, to the Use of Edward Henry Rickards and Charles Hobson, their Executors, Administrators, and Assigns, upon Trusts for securing to Phæbe Virginia Wynne during so long of the joint Lives of herself and John Wynne as they should cohabit together an Annuity of Six hundred Pounds for her separate Use without Anticipation, and subject thereto to the Use of John Wynne and his Assigns during his Life, with Remainder to the Use of Trustees during his Life, upon trust to preserve contingent Remainders, with Remainder to the Use that Phæbe Virginia his Wife, if living and cohabiting with him at his Death, might during the Residue of her Life receive a yearly Rentcharge of Six hundred Pounds for her Jointure, with Powers for the Recovery thereof, and subject thereto to the Use of William Hough Fry

Fry and John Booth Freer, their Executors, Administrators, and Assigns, for a Term of Fifteen hundred Years, upon Trusts for securing the same Rentcharge, and for raising Portions and Maintenance for the younger Children, if any, of John Wynne, and subject thereto to the Use of the First and every other Son of John Wynne successively according to Seniority in Tail Male, with Remainder to the Use of John Wynne, his Heirs and Assigns, for ever; and that in the same Indenture was contained a Power for John Wynne to charge the Garthmeilio Estate with any Sums not exceeding in the whole Twenty thousand Pounds, and to appoint the same in Fee by way of Mortgage, with Power of Sale, for securing the Monies so charged, with Interest thereon; and that by Indentures of the Twelfth Day of June One thousand eight hundred and forty-nine and the Seventeenth Day of January One thousand eight hundred and fifty respectively the Garthmeilio Estate was expressed to be charged by John Wynne, in pursuance of his Power in that Behalf, with the Payment of Sixteen thousand Pounds and Four thousand Pounds respectively to Augustus Mason and John Brownrigg respectively, and to be appointed and conveyed by him to them respectively, and their respective Heirs and Assigns, by way of Mortgage, and with Powers of Sale for securing those Two Sums respectively; and that by means of Two Indentures, each of the Ninth Day of October One thousand eight hundred and fifty-two, and an Indenture of the Twenty-eighth Day of December One thousand eight hundred and fifty-three, and an Indenture of the Ninth Day of February One thousand eight hundred and fifty-four, the several Sums of Twelve thousand Pounds, Two thousand Pounds, Sixteen thousand Pounds, and Four thousand Pounds, so secured, making together Thirty-four thousand Pounds, were assigned to Edward Henry Rickards, and the Garthmeilio Estate, charged therewith, was conveyed to him, his Heirs and Assigns; and that by the Indenture of the Ninth Day of February One thousand eight hundred and fifty-four it was agreed that John Wynne and Ann Wynne should be entitled to Five thousand and fifty-one Pounds Nine Shillings and Twopence, Part of the Thirty-four thousand Pounds, and the same should be paid to Samuel Walker and Andrew Van Sandau, as Trustees thereof; and that by another Indenture of the same Date it was declared that the Five thousand and fifty-one Pounds Nine Shillings and Twopence, and the Interest thereon, and other Monies, should be invested by Samuel Walker and Andrew Van Sandau on Government or Real Securities, and should constitute a Trust Fund for paying to Ann Wynne an Annuity of Six hundred Pounds, which John Wynne thereby covenanted for the Payment of to her, if living at his Death, during the then Residue of her Life, and for further securing to her the Annuity of like Amount granted by the Indenture next hereinafter stated, and Trusts were declared of the Trust Fund accordingly, and

and subject thereto the Income thereof was to be accumulated during the joint Lives of John Wynne and Ann Wynne, in Increase and to be applied as Part of the Trust Fund, and subject thereto the Trust Fund was to be in trust for John Wynne absolutely, and it was provided that if he should purchase in the Name of Ann Wynne an Annuity of Six hundred Pounds, payable to her, in case of his Death in her Lifetime, during the then Residue of her Life, the Trust Fund, or the Balance thereof, should be transferred to him, and it was also agreed that the Trustees of the Trust Fund, at the Request of John Wynne and Ann Wynne, might apply a competent Part of the Trust Fund in or towards the Purchase of the Annuity; and that by another Indenture of the same Date John Wynne charged the Garthmeilio Estate contingently with the Payment to Ann Wynne of an Annuity of Six hundred Pounds during the then Residue of their joint Lives; and that Hyla Ashton Holden claimed to be a Mortgagee, as therein expressed, of the Garthmeilio Estate: And whereas by an Order dated the Ninth Day of July One thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, made by the Lords Justices in the Matter of the Lunacy, the Lords Justices did commit and grant the Custody of the Person and the Regulation and Government of John Wynne, and the Custody of his Estate, to Phæbe Virginia his Wife: And whereas by an Order made in the Matter by the Lords Justices on the Third Day of August One thousand eight hundred and fiftynine the Sale of so much of the Garthmeilio Estate as the Master should consider sufficient to produce Thirty-seven thousand Pounds was ordered: And whereas Master Warren made his Report in the Matter, dated the Nineteenth Day of January One thousand eight hundred and sixty, and it thereby appears that Parts of the Garthmeilio Estate had, with his Approval, been sold in divers Lots for Sums amounting in the whole to Thirty-seven thousand seven hundred and thirty-three Pounds, with the Timber thereon to be taken at a Valuation, which amounted to Eight hundred and forty-five Pounds Nineteen Shillings, and that as the Purchase Monies for those Lots exceeded by Seven hundred and thirty-three Pounds, exclusive of the Value of the Timber, the Sum directed to be raised, he submitted whether the Sale of another Lot (in this Act called Lot 44, Corwen) at Eight hundred Report dated and ninety Pounds should be allowed: And whereas Master Warren, by his Report made in the Matter, dated the Eighteenth Day of May One thousand eight hundred and sixty, and duly confirmed, again submitted the Circumstances relating to the Sale of Lot 44, Corwen: And whereas by an Order made in the Matter by the Lords Justices on the Twenty-fourth Day of July One thousand eight hundred and sixty the Execution of proper Conveyances of some of the Lots so sold (not including Lot 44, Corwen), and the Application of Part of the Monies produced by the Sales, was ordered: And whereas by an Order made in the Matter by the

Lords Justices on the Twenty-fourth Day of July One thousand Order of eight hundred and sixty the Application of other Monies produced by the Sales was ordered: And whereas by an Order of the Lords Justices made in the Matter on the Twenty-second Day of February One thousand eight hundred and sixty-one the Application of other Monies produced by the Sales was ordered for, among other Purposes, the carrying over to an Account in the Matter to be entitled " Ann Wynne and John Wynne, Ann Wynne's Annuity Fund," 1861. a Sum of Consols equal in Value to Five thousand and fifty-one Pounds Nine Shillings and Twopence, with Interest thereon as therein expressed, and for the Application of the Dividends thereon in the Purchase of Consols in trust in the Matter the like Account, and also for the taking of Proceedings for carrying over a Sum of Consols in trust in the Matter the like Account; and it was ordered that in the event therein expressed the Sale of Lot 44, Corwen should be carried into effect: And whereas by an Order Order of made in the Matter by the Lords Justices on the Eighteenth Day of Lords Jus-July One thousand eight hundred and sixty-two the Application of tices dated July other Monies produced by the Sales was ordered: And whereas 1862. Master Warren, by his Report made in the Matter, dated the Report Twentieth Day of July One thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, dated 20th July 1863. certified divers Matters, whereby it appears that the Event in which the Sale of Lot 44, Corwen was to be carried into effect had happened, and the Master had approved the Sale thereof: And Order of whereas by an Order made in the Matter by the Lords Justices on the Twenty-eighth Day of July One thousand eight hundred and 28th July sixty-three it was ordered that such Parts of the Garthmeilio Estate 1863. as the Masters in Lunacy should consider would be sufficient, with the Proceeds of the Sales of Lot 44, Corwen and another Lot, to raise what was required for the Payments therein expressed, should be sold, with the Approbation of the Masters: And whereas Master Warren Report by his Report made in the Matter, dated the Twenty-seventh Day of dated 27th November One thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, certified the Sale of Parts of the Garthmeilio Estate (therein referred to as Lots 1, 3, 4, and 5), and his Allowance thereof: And whereas by an Order of Order made in the Matter by the Lords Justices on the First Day of Lords Jus-July One thousand eight hundred and sixty-four the Lords Justices being of opinion that it was for the Interest of John Wynne that of Act of Application should be made for an Act of Parliament for the Purposes Parliament therein-after expressed, ordered that it should be referred to the July 1864. Masters in Lunacy to settle and approve a Bill to be presented to Parliament for an Act enabling Trustees, to be approved by the Masters in Lunacy, to raise by Sale of a sufficient Part of the Garthmeilio Estate remaining unsold such a Sum as would, with the Proceeds of the Bank Annuities for the Time being standing in trust in the Matter "the Account of Ann Wynne and John Wynne, " Ann [Private.]

" Ann Wynne's Annuity Fund," and of the Bank Annuities for the Time being standing in trust in the Matter the Account entitled " Proceeds of Sale of Part of Garthmeilio Estate" be sufficient, in the Opinion of the Master in Lunacy, to purchase a Government Annuity of Six hundred Pounds payable during the Life of Anne Wynne, and to provide for the Discharge of the Balance owing to Hyla Ashton Holden, and for the Discharge of the other Claims, and the Costs, and Costs, Charges, and Expenses therein mentioned, and the Bill was to contain all proper Provisions for adopting and confirming the Sales therein referred to, and for making such further Sales as might be necessary, and ordered that Phæbe Virginia Wynne, as Committee of the Estate of John Wynne, in his Name and on his Behalf, should apply to Parliament for an Act for the Purposes, and take such Steps as should be necessary in support of the Application: And whereas Master Warren, by his Report made in the Matter, dated the Twenty-ninth Day of April One thousand eight hundred and sixtyfive, and duly confirmed, certified to the following Effect; (that is to say,)

Report dated 29th April 1865.

That since the Death of Robert Watkin Wynne, under whose Will John Wynne claims, divers Improvements to the Garthmeilio Estate as thereby devised have been made, and divers Additions are about to be made on the Inclosure of Common or Waste Lands:

That the Limitation in the Post-Nuptial Settlement of the Ninth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and forty-nine to Edward Henry Rickards and Charles Hobson was a Limitation to them for a Term of One hundred Years:

That that Term is still vested in Edward Henry Rickards and Charles Hobson upon the Trusts thereof declared by the Post-Nuptial Settlement:

That the Term of One thousand five hundred Years by the Post-Nuptial Settlement limited to William Hough Fry and John Booth Freer is still vested in them upon the Trusts declared thereof by the Post-Nuptial Settlement:

That the legal Estate in Fee in those Parts of the Garthmeilio Estate which have been sold but have not yet been conveyed to the Purchasers thereof, and in those Parts of that Estate which remain unsold, is considered to be outstanding in Edward Henry Richards, who, except as regards Costs due to him, is a satisfied Incumbrancer on that Estate:

That the Sum of Six thousand nine hundred and forty-six Pounds Nineteen Shillings and Eightpence Consols is now standing to the Credit of the Matter to the Account of Ann Wynne and John Wynne, Ann Wynne's Annuity Fund, and represents the Five thousand and fifty-one Pounds Nine Shillings and Two-

pence which was agreed to be paid to Samuel Walker and Andrew Van Sandau as Trustees for Ann Wynne, and the Accumulations thereof:

That the Trusteeship of Samuel Walker and Andrew Van Sandau in respect thereof has ceased:

That the Purchasers of those Parts of the Garthmeilio Estate which have been sold to them, but have not yet been conveyed to them, have paid their respective Purchase Monies, and have been let into possession of the Lots purchased by them respectively:

That the only Sums, besides Ann Wynne's Annuity Fund, which are standing to the Credit of the Matter, are a Sum of Three thousand nine hundred and forty Pounds and Tenpence Bank Three Pounds per Cent. Annuities, and the Sum of Fifty-seven Pounds Twelve Shillings and Sixpence Cash, standing to the Account "Proceeds of Sale of Part of Garthmeilio Estate," and a Sum of Seventy-six Pounds Seven Shillings and Fivepence in Cash standing to the Credit of the Account "John Wynne a Person of unsound Mind," and a Sum of One hundred and fifty-two Pounds Seven Shillings Consolidated Bank Annuities, and Eight Pounds Seventeen Shillings and Tenpence Cash, standing to the Credit of the Account "The Policy Fund," which last-mentioned Sum of Consols and Cash are required for the Purpose of keeping up a Policy on the Life of the said John Wynne:

That all the other Monies raised by the Sale of Parts of the Garthmeilio Estate have, in accordance with divers Orders made in the Matter by the Lords Justices, been applied partly in or towards the Discharge of Incumbrances affecting the Garthmeilio Estate, and partly in the Payment of Costs, and for other Purposes:

That the only Incumbrances created by John Wynne, and now affecting the Garthmeilio Estate, are the Two successive Annuities of Six hundred Pounds each for Phæbe Virginia his Wife, and the Two successive Annuities of Six hundred Pounds each for Ann Wynne, and the Balance of a Principal Sum due to Hyla Ashton Holden, with an Arrear of Interest thereon:

That in addition to these Incumbrances a Sum of Four thousand Pounds or thereabouts is due for John Wynne's private Debts not secured on the Garthmeilio Estate, and further Sums are due for Costs:

That the net Income from those Parts of the Garthmeilio Estate which remain unsold, after deducting the Two Annuities of Six hundred Pounds and Six hundred Pounds, is Five hundred Pounds a Year or thereabouts, which is insufficient for the Payment of the Incumbrances thereon and the Debts and

Costs

Costs to the Payment of which John Wynne or his Estate is liable:

That for a considerable Time John Wynne has been chiefly supported by his Wife out of her own Income, which consists exclusively of her present Annuity of Six hundred Pounds:

That in the Opinion of competent Medical Practitioners conversant with Lunacy who had given Evidence in the Matter there is no Prospect of the Recovery of John Wynne from his State of unsound Mind:

That, having regard to the Contingency, however remote, of there being hereafter Issue Male of John Wynne to take under the Limitations of the Post-Nuptial Settlement, the Master submitted that if further Sales of the Garthmeilio Estate were made for the Purposes expressed in the recited Order of the Lords Justices of the First Day of July One thousand eight hundred and sixty-four, and the Sales already made and thereby directed to be confirmed were confirmed, it would be right that by means of Assurance Provision should be made for securing that in the event of John Wynne's dying and leaving Issue Male entitled " under the Post-Nuptial Settlement a Sum equal to the Amount by which the Proceeds of the Sales exceeded Thirty-four thousand Pounds and the Costs of raising the same should be invested in the Purchase of Lands to be settled to the Uses of the Post-Nuptial Settlement, to take effect as from the Death of John Wynne:

That such an Assurance could be effected on Payment of a single Premium in respect of the Amount so assured:

That the raising of the Sum requisite for the Payment of that Premium ought to be One of the Objects of the Sales:

That by reason of the Doubts raised as to the Validity of the Sales of Parts of the Garthmeilio Estate which have been made for raising Monies in excess of Thirty-four thousand Pounds, and the Costs of raising the same, Edward Henry Rickards has declined to convey the legal Estate therein to the Purchasers thereof:

That the Persons living and interested as Trustees in the unsold Parts of the Garthmeilio Estate are Edward Henry Rickards and Charles Hobson as Trustees of the One hundred Years Term, and William Hough Fry and John Booth Freer as Trustees of the One thousand five hundred Years Term, and Edward Henry Rickards as Trustee of the Fee:

That the Persons living and interested as Purchasers of those Parts of the Garthmeilio Estate which have been sold, but have not yet been conveyed to the Purchasers thereof, are Robert Jones, and Edward Roberts, and William Shipley Conway, and David Roberts, and William Williams respectively:

That

That the Persons living and interested beneficially in the unsold Parts of the Garthmeilio Estate are John Wynne and Phæbe Virginia his Wife, and Ann Wynne: And that the Master had settled and approved the Bill for this Act:

And whereas John Booth Freer, since the making of the last-mentioned Report, and, namely, on the Twenty-second Day of June One thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, died, and the Term of One thousand five hundred Years by the Post-Nuptial Settlement limited to William Hough Fry and John Booth Freer is now vested in William Hough Fry, as the surviving Trustee thereof, upon the Trust thereby declared, and who is now living, and interested, as the surviving Trustee of that Term, in the unsold Parts of the Garthmeilio Estate: And whereas Lot 44 Corwen, and Lots 1, 3, 4, and 5, being respectively those Parts of the Garthmeilio Estate which have been sold, but which have not yet been conveyed to the Purchasers thereof, and the Names and Descriptions of those Purchasers respectively, are set forth in the First Schedule to this Act annexed, and those Parts of the Garthmeilio Estate are in this Act referred to as "the Five Lots:" And whereas those Parts of the Garthmeilio Estate which still remain unsold are specified in the Second Schedule to this Act annexed, and are in this Act referred to as "the Trust Estate:" And whereas the Lords Justices, in pursuance of their recited Order of the First Day of July One thousand eight hundred and sixty-four, and the recited Report by Master Warren of the Twenty-ninth Day of April One thousand eight hundred and sixty-five respectively, have approved the Draft of this Bill: And whereas the Objects of this Act cannot be attained without the Authority of Parliament: Wherefore Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal Subject, Phæbe Virginia Wynne, as well in her Character of Committee of John Wynne the Lunatic as also in her Character of an Incumbrancer on his Estate, doth most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, as follows; (that is to say,)

- 1. This Act may for all Purposes be cited as "Wynne's Estate Short Title. Act, 1865."
- 2. The Expression "the Court" in this Act has the same Interpreta-Meaning as by "The Lunacy Regulation Act, 1853," is given to the Terms. Expression "the Lord Chancellor intrusted as aforesaid;" and the several Expressions and Words to which by that Act Meanings are assigned have in this Act the same respective Meanings, unless excluded by the Subject or Context.

Wynne's Estate Act, 1865.

Court to order Execution of Powers of Act.

3. The Court from Time to Time may make and give all such Orders and Directions whatsoever, for and with respect to the Exercise of the several Powers of this Act, and all Matters incidental or accessory thereto, and with respect to Costs, and the Taxation, Allowance, and Payment of Costs, as the Court think fit, and the Court shall have full Jurisdiction and Authority to give Effect to those Powers, and all Things from Time to Time done in and about the Execution thereof or with reference thereto, and with respect to Costs.

Order of Court on Petition or Motion.

4. The Court from Time to Time may make and give any Orders and Directions for the Purposes of this Act, either on Petition presented in a summary Way, or by Motion, and on Notice to such Persons, if any, as the Court direct; and any Application to the Court by or on the Part of the Trustees may be made by all or any of the Trustees.

Court may approve Scheme for Execution of Act.

5. The Court from Time to Time may, by any Order or Direction, approve a Scheme for the Exercise by the Trustees of any of the Powers of this Act; and any Scheme so approved may provide in such general Terms, or in such Detail as the Court think fit, for the Exercise thereof, and may give to or impose on the Trustees such Latitude of Discretion or such Restraint with respect to the Exercise thereof as the Court think fit; provided that, with a view to lessening the Expense of executing this Act, every such Scheme shall be in such general Terms and give such Latitude of Discretion to the Trustees as the Court think fit.

Validity of Orders of Court, and Acts of Trustees thereunder.

6. Every Order and Direction of the Court expressed to be made under the Authority of this Act, and appearing to be made for any of the Purposes of this Act, and notwithstanding its being such as if this Act were not passed would be in part or altogether beyond or in excess of the ordinary Jurisdiction of the Court, and everything whatsoever from Time to Time done by the Trustees or any other Persons in pursuance of or in conformity with every such Order and Direction respectively, shall be absolutely valid, and shall accordingly, at Law and in Equity, bind all Parties interested.

Sales of the Five Lots confirmed.

7. The Sales of the Five Lots respectively to the several Persons whose Names are given in the First Schedule to this Act annexed are by this Act confirmed, and made valid and effectual, to all Intents and Purposes whatsoever, and may and shall be carried into full Effect; and in order thereto the Court may make such Orders vesting those Lots respectively in those Persons respectively as the Court think fit.

8. The Sales and Conveyances of the Five Lots respectively validity of which are by this Act confirmed, and all Sales and Conveyances made under this Act of any Parts of the Trust Estate, and the Application under any Orders of the Court already or hereafter made of the Proceeds of those Sales respectively, shall respectively be valid and effectual to all Intents and Purposes, and shall have Effect and Proceeds of Validity as if the same respectively were made in due pursuance of Sales. good and sufficient Powers of Sale and other Powers in that Behalf created by John Wynne before the making of and paramount to his Post-Nuptial Settlement, and overriding the same, and all subsequent Assurances by him: of or affecting the Garthmeilio Estate or any Part thereof, and as if at the Time of the Creation of the Powers he, being of sound and disposing Mind, Memory, and Understanding, had been seised in Fee Simple absolute in possession of the Garthmeilio Estate, free from all Incumbrances.

Sales of the Five Lots, and of Sales under Act, and of Application of

9.
