The Hill Farming Improvements (Piers, Etc.) Order, 1949

Made	17th November 1949

In pursuance of subsection (4) of section 1 of the Hill Farming Act, 1946 the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries and the Secretary of State for Scotland hereby make the following Order:—

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Hill Farming Improvements (Piers, etc.) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of December, 1949.

**2.** In paragraph 4 of the First Schedule to the said Act, after the word "bridges" there shall be inserted the words "and of piers, jetties or slips", and the kinds of operations specified in the said Schedule shall include the making or improvement of piers, jetties or slips accordingly.
