

The Revision of the Army and Air Force Acts (Transitional Provisions) Act, 1955 (Appointed Day) Order, 1955

Made - - - - 1st December, 1955

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 1st day of December, 1955

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas it is provided by subsection (3) of section 6 of the Revision of the Army and Air Force Acts (Transitional Provisions) Act, 1955(b), that the expression "the appointed day" means such day as Her Majesty may by Order in Council appoint:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in pursuance of the said subsection (3) is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. In the Revision of the Army and Air Force Acts (Transitional Provisions) Act, 1955(b), the expression "the appointed day" shall mean the first day of January nineteen hundred and fifty-seven.

2. This Order may be cited as the Revision of the Army and Air Force Acts (Transitional Provisions) Act, 1955 (Appointed Day) Order, 1955.
