COMMENCEMENT OF ACT

1959 No. 80 (C. 2)

The Agriculture Act, 1958 (Appointed Day) (England and Wales) Order, 1959

Made - - - - - 15th January, 1959

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by subsection (1) of Section 9 of the Agriculture Act, 1958(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Agriculture Act, 1958 (Appointed Day) (England and Wales) Order, 1959.

2. As respects England and Wales for the purposes of Sections 3, 4 and 10 of, and paragraphs 1, 8, 9, 11, 14, 17, 18, 19, 23, 24 and 28 of the First Schedule to the Agriculture Act, 1958, the appointed day shall be the twenty-sixth day of January, 1959.

In Witness whereof the Official Seal of the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food is hereunto affixed this fifteenth day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but it is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Agriculture Act, 1958, provides that certain of its provisions shall come into operation on the appointed day. This Order fixes the appointed day, in relation to England and Wales as 26th January, 1959, and has the effect of bringing into operation on that date all the provisions of the Act, other than those which came into force on 1st August, 1958, the date on which the Act received the Royal Assent.
