### PART IV

#### RAISING AND LOWERING, ETC

#### Indication of safe working loads

**38.**—(1) A table showing the safe working load of every chain, rope and article of lifting gear in use, and, in the case of a multiple sling, the safe working loads at different angles of the legs, shall be posted in a permanent position in the store in which the chains, ropes and articles of lifting gear are kept; so, however, that this Regulation shall not apply to any article of lifting gear if the safe working loads thereof, or, in the case of a multiple sling, the safe working loads at different angles of the legs, is or are plainly marked upon it.

- (2) Nothing in this Regulation shall apply to chains, ropes or lifting gear-
  - (a) to which the Docks Regulations, 1934 apply and which satisfy the requirements of those Regulations; or
  - (b) which are permanently attached to a structure.
