The Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction (Discipline) Rules 1964

Representation of parties

61.—(1) At the hearing of any interlocutory application under these rules made before the conclusion of the inquiry into the complaint, either party may appear in person or, if he so desires, be assisted or represented by a friend or adviser(1).

(2) In any subsequent proceedings either party may appear in person or be represented by counsel or solicitor.

(1) As regards the inquiry itself, similar provision is made by sections 24(2), 33(5) and 42(4) of the Measure.
