## SHERIFF COURT, SCOTLAND

## Act of Sederunt (Confirmation of Executors Amendment) 1966

*Made* - - - - 17th May 1966

*Coming into Operation* 10th June 1966

The Lords of Council and Session, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section 18 of the Confirmation of Executors (Scotland) Act 1858(a), section 16 of the Sheriff Courts and Legal Officers (Scotland) Act 1927(b), section 34 of the Administration of Justice (Scotland) Act 1933(c), section 22 of the Succession (Scotland) Act 1964(d), and of all other powers competent to them in that behalf, do hereby enact and declare as follows:—

1. The Act of Sederunt (Confirmation of Executors) 1964(e) shall be amended by deleting section 1 thereof and by substituting therefor a new section 1 as follows:—

“ The inventory embodied in or appended to the confirmation of an executor, or embodied in or appended to an eik to the confirmation of an executor, shall include, in respect of any heritable property forming part of, or any heritable property an interest in which forms part of, the estate of the deceased person, and falling to be administered under the law of Scotland, such a description as will be sufficient to identify the property or interest therein as “ a separate item in the deceased person’s estate.”

2. This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Confirmation of Executors Amendment) 1966, and shall come into operation on 10th June 1966.

And the Lords appoint this Act of Sederunt to be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.
