## LOCAL GOVERNMENT, ENGLAND AND WALES

The School Health Service Amending Regulations 1966

Made	27th January 1966
Laid before Parliament	9th February 1966
Coming into Operation	1st April 1966

The Secretary of State for Education and Science, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 3(4) of the Local Government Act 1958(a), hereby makes the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the School Health Service Amending Regulations 1966 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1966.

2. The regulations hereby amended are the School Health Service Regulations 1959(b), hereinafter called "the existing regulations".

3. The following regulation shall be inserted after Regulation 5 of the existing regulations:—

" Professions Supplementary to Medicine"

"5A. No person shall be employed by an authority for the purposes of the school health service in the capacity of chiropodist, dietitian, medical laboratory technician, occupational therapist, physiotherapist, radiographer or remedial gymnast unless he is registered in respect of the profession appropriate to the work for which he is employed."

These regulations provide that from 1st April 1966 persons in Professions Supplementary to Medicine may not be employed in the School Health Service unless they are registered.
