The Import Duties (General) (No. 7) Order 1967

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>23rd October 1967</i>
<i>Laid before the House of Commons</i>	<i>27th October 1967</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>2nd November 1967</i>

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by sections 1, 2 and 13 of the Import Duties Act 1958(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Board of Trade hereby make the following Order:—

1. In Schedule 1 to the Import Duties (General) (No. 11) Order 1966(b) (which Schedule by reference to the Customs Tariff 1959 sets out the import duties chargeable under the Import Duties Act 1958), in heading 29.35, the following shall be inserted after subheading (E), and the existing subheading (F) shall accordingly become (G):—

“(F) 1,6—Hexanolactam 16% —”

2.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (General) (No. 7) Order 1967.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) This Order shall come into operation on 2nd November 1967.

This Order reduces the full rate of duty on 1,6—Hexanolactam from 33½% to 16% ad valorem.
