The Prices and Incomes (Continuous Review) (No. 1)

Order 1967

<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	30th October 1967
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	1st November 1967

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 3(1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order, which may be cited as the Prices and Incomes (Continuous Review) (No. 1) Order 1967, shall come into operation on 1st November 1967.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. Section 3 of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966 (which empowers the Secretary of State, or him and any other Minister acting jointly, to instruct the National Board for Prices and Incomes to keep under continuous review any question concerning all or any of the incomes or prices or charges or other matters to which that section is applied) shall apply to incomes of the descriptions specified in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

1. The remuneration of the academic staff of universities;
2. The pay, allowances, pensions and gratuities of members of the naval, military or air forces of the Crown and of any women's service administered by the Defence Council.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order applies section 3 of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966 (which empowers the Secretary of State, or him and any other Minister acting jointly, to instruct the National Board for Prices and Incomes to keep under continuous review any question concerning all or any of the incomes or prices or charges or other matters to which that section is applied) to the incomes specified in the Schedule to the Order.
