I, Gerald, Baron Gardiner, Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, in exercise of the power conferred on me by section 15 of the Justices of the Peace Act 1949(a), as extended by section 122 of the Magistrates' Courts Act 1952(b), do hereby, after consultation with the Rule Committee appointed under the said section 15, make the following Rules:—

1. For Rule 15(2) of the Summary Jurisdiction (Children and Young Persons) Rules 1933(c) as substituted by Rule 1 of the Summary Jurisdiction (Children and Young Persons) Rules 1963(d), there shall be substituted the following paragraphs:—

'(2) Where the application is made under section 66 or 84(6) of the Act, otherwise than by a local authority, or under section 84(7), the applicant shall send a notice to the relevant local authority specifying the grounds for the application and the date, time and place of the hearing, and any report furnished by that local authority shall be taken into consideration by the court.

(3) In the last foregoing paragraph "the relevant local authority" means in the case of an application concerning a child or young person who is committed to the care of a local authority as a fit person, or is under the supervision of a local authority, that local authority and in any other case the local authority for the district in which the respondent resides.

(4) Where an application is made concerning a child or young person who is committed to the care of a fit person or is under the supervision of a person (other than, in either case, a local authority or the applicant), the applicant shall send a notice to that person specifying the grounds for the application and the date, time and place of the hearing.'

2. These Rules may be cited as the Summary Jurisdiction (Children and Young Persons) Rules 1967 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1968.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the Rules.)*

These Rules amend the Summary Jurisdiction (Children and Young Persons) Rules 1933 and provide that an applicant for the revocation or variation of a fit person or supervision order in which a local authority is named shall give notice of the application to that authority and in any other case to the fit person or supervisor and to the local authority of the area in which the child or young person resides.
