SHOPS AND OFFICES

The Offices, Shops and Railway Premises Annual Reports Order 1967

Made - - - 10th November 1967 Coming into Operation 21st November 1967

The Minister of Labour by virtue of the powers conferred on him by sections 60(1) and 80(3) of the Offices, Shops and Railway Premises Act 1963(a) (hereafter in this Order referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Offices, Shops and Railway Premises Annual Reports Order 1967 and shall come into operation on 21st November 1967.
- (2) The Offices, Shops and Railway Premises Annual Reports Order 1964(b) is hereby revoked.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament, and as if this Order and the Order hereby revoked were Acts of Parliament.
- 3. Every annual report made to the Minister of Labour in pursuance of section 60(1) of the Act—
 - (a) in the case of a report made by any local authority or by the Greater London Council, shall contain particulars with respect to the matters arising under the Act which are specified in Schedule 1 to this Order; and
 - (b) in the case of a report made by any authority discharging in any area the functions of fire authority under the Fire Services Act 1947(d), shall contain particulars with respect to the matters arising under the Act which are specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
