**The West Indies Act 1967 (Appointed Days)
Order 1967**

Made - - - - *22nd February 1967*

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 22nd day of February 1967

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her in that behalf by section 19(1) of the West Indies Act 1967(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the West Indies Act 1967 (Appointed Days) Order 1967. Citation.

2.—(1) The appointed day in relation to Antigua and to Saint Christopher, Nevis and Anguilla shall be 27th February 1967. Appointment of days of assumption of associated status by certain territories.

(2) The appointed day in relation to Dominica and to Saint Lucia shall be 1st March 1967.

(3) The appointed day in relation to Grenada shall be 3rd March 1967.
