The Register of Patent Agents (Amendment) Rules 1968

The Board of Trade, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by section 94 of the Patents Act 1949(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Rules:—

1. The Register of Patent Agents Rules 1950(b), as amended (c), shall have effect as if for Schedule 3 (which sets out the fees payable) there were substituted the Schedule hereto.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply to the interpretation of these

Rules as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. These Rules may be cited as the Register of Patent Agents (Amendment)

Rules 1968 and shall come into operation on 2nd January 1969.
