The Police (Amendment) (No. 4) Regulations 1968

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 33 of the Police Act 1964(a), and after consulting the Police Council for Great Britain in accordance with section 45(4) of that Act, I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) In paragraph (2) of Regulation 55 of the principal Regulations (which relates to promotion examination allowances) for the words “A sergeant” there shall be substituted the words “A constable or sergeant”.

(2) In paragraph (3) of the said Regulation 55 for the words “A promotion examination allowance shall not be payable to a constable under paragraph (1), or to a sergeant under paragraph (2)” there shall be substituted the words “A constables promotion examination allowance or a sergeants promotion examination allowance shall not be payable to a member of a police force”.

2. In Schedule 6 to the principal Regulations (which, as set out in the Appendix to the Police (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1968(b), relates to motor vehicle allowances)—

(a) for the Table in paragraph 1 there shall be substituted the following Table:—

(b) for the Table in paragraph 2 there shall be substituted the following Table:—

3.—(1) In the year ending 30th April 1969 a motor vehicle allowance payable under Regulation 48 of the principal Regulations shall be calculated as hereinafter provided.

(2) So far as the motor vehicle allowance falls to be calculated by reference to completed months of authorised use ending, or mileage of authorised use performed, on or after 1st August 1968, it shall be calculated in accordance with the principal Regulations as amended by Regulation 2 of these Regulations, which shall have effect accordingly.

(3) Nothing in Regulation 2 of these Regulations shall affect the calculation of the motor vehicle allowance so far as it falls to be calculated by reference to completed months of authorised use ending, or mileage of authorised use performed, before 1st August 1968.

4. In these Regulations any reference to the principal Regulations is a reference to the Police Regulations 1968(a), as amended (b).

5.—(1) These Regulations shall come into operation on 20th November 1968 and, save as provided in Regulation 3 thereof, shall have effect as from that date.

(2) These Regulations may be cited as the Police (Amendment) (No. 4) Regulations 1968.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Police Regulations 1968.

Regulation 1 provides that a constable who obtains a pass in the qualifying examination for promotion from sergeant to inspector shall be paid a sergeants promotion examination allowance.

Regulation 2 increases the rates at which motor vehicle allowances are payable. These allowances are payable on an annual basis and are calculated by reference to completed months of authorised use and mileage performed in the year in question.

Regulation 3 makes transitory provision for the calculation of these allowances in the year ending 30th April 1969 and provides (in exercise of the power conferred by section 33 (4) of the Police Act 1964) that Regulation 2 shall have effect as from 1st August 1968 as respects the calculation of motor vehicle allowances by reference to months of use completed, or mileage performed, on or after that date.
