CLEAN AIR

The Clean Air Act 1968 (Commencement No. 1) Order 1968

Made - - - 2nd December 1968

The Minister of Housing and Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 15(3) of the Clean Air Act 1968(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

- 1. This order may be cited as the Clean Air Act 1968 (Commencement No. 1) Order 1968.
- 2. The appointed day for the coming into force of the provisions of the Clean Air Act 1968 specified in the Schedule to this order in their application to England and Wales shall be 1st April 1969.
