The Civil Defence Corps (Revocation) Regulations 1968

Laid before Parliament in draftMade - - - 29th March 1968Coming into Operation1st April 1968

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 2 of the Civil Defence Act 1948(a), I hereby make the following Regulations, a draft of which has been laid before Parliament and approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:—

1. The following Regulations are hereby revoked, namely,

The Civil Defence Corps Regulations 1949(b),

The Civil Defence Corps (Scunthorpe) Regulations 1951(c).

2.—(1) Section 38 of the Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply as if these Regulations were an Act of Parliament and as if the Regulations revoked by these Regulations were Acts of Parliament repealed by an Act of Parliament.

(2) These Regulations may be cited as the Civil Defence Corps (Revocation) Regulations 1968 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1968.
