In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 2 as read with the proviso to subsection (2) of section 9 of the Civil Defence Act 1948(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations, a draft of which has been laid before Parliament and approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:—

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Civil Defence Corps (Scotland) (Revocation) Regulations 1968 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1968.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The Civil Defence Corps (Scotland) Regulations 1949(c) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the regulations.)

These regulations revoke the Civil Defence Corps (Scotland) Regulations 1949 which made it the function of certain local authorities to organise divisions of the Civil Defence Corps.
