The Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under section 62(4) of the Water (Scotland) Act 1946(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

- 1. This order may be cited as the Water Byelaws (Extension of Operation) Order 1968.
- 2. Any byelaws made under section 61 of the Water (Scotland) Act 1946 (which confers power to make byelaws for preventing pollution of water), being byelaws which would, but for this order, cease to have effect before 31st December 1968 as a consequence of section 62(4) of the said Act, shall remain in force until that day.
