In exercise of the power conferred upon me by paragraph 1 of Schedule 4 to the Children and Young Persons Act 1933(a), I hereby make the following Rules:—

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Approved School Rules 1969 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1969.
- 2. For Rule 30A(3) of the Approved School Rules 1933(b), as amended (c), (which relates to the duration of home leave) there shall be substituted the following provision:—
 - "(3) Except with the permission of the Chief Inspector home leave shall not be granted in excess of sixteen days at any one time or forty-five days in any year."
