## SUGAR

**The Sugar (Surcharge Remission) (Amendment) Order 1969**

*Made* - - - 21st October 1969

*Laid before Parliament* 29th October 1969

*Coming into Operation* 30th October 1969

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 58 of the Finance Act 1968(a) construed as one with the Sugar Act 1956(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of prescribing such goods as it appears to him to be expedient to prescribe for the purposes of subsection (1)(b) of that section in the interests of the national economy, hereby makes the following order:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Sugar (Surcharge Remission) (Amendment) Order 1969, and shall come into operation on 30th October 1969.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Sugar (Surcharge Remission) Order 1968(d) shall be amended by adding to the Schedule thereto (which specifies the descriptions of goods which are prescribed for the purposes of subsection (1)(b) of section 58 of the Finance Act 1968) the following items:—

"Citric acid and its salts  
Vitamin B<sub>12</sub>  
Foundry sand bonding media  
Enzyme solutions".

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This order amends the Sugar (Surcharge Remission) Order 1968 by adding a number of items to the Schedule thereto which lists the descriptions of goods in respect of whose manufacture sugar surcharge may be remitted or repaid in accordance with the provisions of section 58(1)(b) of the Finance Act 1968.
