The Minister of Transport hereby makes this Order in exercise of his powers under section 38(2) of the Vehicle and Driving Licences Act 1969(a) and of all other enabling powers.

1. This Order may be cited as the Vehicle and Driving Licences Act 1969 (Commencement No. 3) Order 1969.

2. Section 2(3) and (4) of the Vehicle and Driving Licences Act 1969 shall come into operation on the 19th November 1969.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**  
(*This Note is not part of the Order.*)

This Order brings into operation on the 19th November 1969 the following provisions of the Vehicle and Driving Licences Act 1969:—

Section 2(3), which empowers the Minister of Transport to make regulations providing for compensation for persons who suffer loss as a result of the transfer of functions envisaged by section 1.

Section 2(4), which protects certain superannuation rights of local government employees who, as a result of the transfer of functions envisaged by section 1, either:—

- (a) lose their employment with a local authority and subsequently transfer to other specified superannuable employment, or
  - (b) remain employed by the local authority concerned but at a reduced rate of remuneration.
