## The Police (Scotland) Amendment (No. 4) Regulations 1969

<i>Made</i> - - -	4th November 1969
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	20th November 1969
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	21st November 1969

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 26 of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consulting the Police Council for Great Britain in accordance with section 26(8) of the said Act of 1967, I hereby make the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Police (Scotland) Amendment (No. 4) Regulations 1969.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on 21st November 1969 and shall have effect as from 1st September 1969.

2. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Police (Scotland) Regulations 1968(b).

3. In Schedule 5 of the principal regulations (which relates to refreshment, subsistence and lodging allowances) for the table in paragraph 1 there shall be substituted the following table:—
