In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 53(3) of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967(a), I hereby make the following order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Police (Scotland) Act 1967 (Commencement) Order 1969 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1970.
2. Section 39 of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967 shall come into operation on 1st January 1970.

This Order brings into force on 1st January 1970 section 39 of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967 which relates to liability for the wrongful acts of constables and is the only provision of the said Act which is not already in operation.
