The Army Terms of Service (Amendment) Regulations 1969

The Defence Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 2 of the Armed Forces Act 1966(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations :—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Army Terms of Service (Amendment) Regulations 1969 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1969.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Army Terms of Service Regulations 1967(c) shall have effect as though the following provisions were omitted :—

(a) in Regulation 4(1)(b) (which confers on the persons described in Schedule 1 to the Regulations a right to be transferred to the reserve at the end of the first three years of service) the words from “if he” to “Regulations”; and

(b) Schedule 1.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Army Terms of Service Regulations 1967 to extend the right to be transferred to the reserve at the end of the first three years of service to all persons who are enlisted for a term of more than 12 years instead of only to persons described in Schedule 1 to those Regulations.
