## NURSES AND MIDWIVES

**The Enrolled Nurses (Amendment) Rules, Approval Instrument  
1970**

<i>Made</i>	- - -	13th July 1970

The Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of his powers under section 32(1) of the Nurses Act 1957(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby approves the rules made by the General Nursing Council for England and Wales as set out in the Schedule hereto.

This Instrument may be cited as the Enrolled Nurses (Amendment) Rules, Approval Instrument 1970 and shall come into operation on 24th July 1970.

## SCHEDULE

## THE GENERAL NURSING COUNCIL FOR ENGLAND AND WALES

*The Nurses Acts 1957 to 1969*

The General Nursing Council for England and Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 7(1), 23 and 30 of the Nurses Act 1957, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Enrolled Nurses (Amendment) Rules 1970.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) applies to the interpretation of these Rules as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The Enrolled Nurses Rules 1969(c) shall be amended as follows:—
  - (a) In rule 35 after the definition of “crime” there shall be inserted the following definition:—
 

“ “Investigating Committee” means the Investigating Committee constituted under rule 74 of the Nurses Rules 1969 ; ”
  - (b) For rule 62 there shall be substituted the following rule:—
 

“62. In the event of loss of, or damage to, the original permit, an enrolled nurse desirous of obtaining a duplicate permit shall make application to the Registrar on a form to be supplied by the Council and shall pay a fee of 5s. 0d. with her application. The fee payable for any further permit shall be 10s. 0d.”
  - (c) In rule 66 for the words from “In the event of” to the end of the rule there shall be substituted the following words:—
 

“In the event of loss of, or damage to, a badge the Council may, on application made to the Registrar on a form supplied by the Council and on payment of a sum of £1 1s. 0d., issue a duplicate badge.”

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Instrument.)*

The Rules approved by this Instrument amend the Enrolled Nurses Rules 1969 to include a definition of Investigating Committee and to restore to the level obtaining prior to those Rules the amounts chargeable by the General Nursing Council for a duplicate permit to wear the prescribed uniform or for issuing a duplicate of the prescribed badge.
