## CEREALS MARKETING

**The Home-Grown Cereals Authority (Additional Functions)  
(Variation) Order 1970***Made* - - - 27th July 1970*Laid before Parliament* 5th August 1970*Coming into Operation* 6th August 1970

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with agriculture in Scotland and Northern Ireland and the Secretary of State for Wales, acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 7 of the Cereals Marketing Act 1965(a) as extended by section 107 of the Agriculture Act 1970(b) and as read with the Transfer of Functions (Wales) Order 1969(c) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following order, it appearing to them after consultation with the Home-Grown Cereals Authority (hereinafter referred to as "the Authority") that for the purpose of improving the marketing of home-grown cereals, including maize grown in the United Kingdom, it is expedient for the Authority to perform in relation to such maize the additional non-trading functions already conferred on the Authority by the Home-Grown Cereals Authority (Additional Functions) Order 1970(d) in relation to home-grown cereals, being functions which the said Ministers certify to be in their opinion similar in character to those conferred on the Authority by section 6 of the said Act of 1965 as so extended :—

*Citation, commencement and interpretation*

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Home-Grown Cereals Authority (Additional Functions) (Variation) Order 1970, and shall come into operation on 6th August 1970.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(e) shall apply to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

*Variation of the Home-Grown Cereals Authority (Additional Functions) Order 1970*

2. The provisions of article 2 of the Home-Grown Cereals Authority (Additional Functions) Order 1970 (which confer on the Authority additional non-trading functions enabling the Authority to conduct research or other experimental work in connection with the assessment and development of home-grown cereals for new or existing uses or processes) shall have effect as if the reference therein to home-grown cereals included a reference to maize grown in the United Kingdom.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This order, which comes into operation on 6th August 1970, varies the Home-Grown Cereals Authority (Additional Functions) Order 1970 so as to enable the Authority to extend their research and experimental work in connection with the assessment and development of home-grown cereals for new or existing uses or processes to include maize grown in the United Kingdom. These additional functions are similar in character to functions already conferred on the Authority by section 6 of the Cereals Marketing Act 1965.
