The Import Duty Drawbacks (No. 5) Order 1970

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by sections 9 and 13 of, and Schedule 5 to, the Import Duties Act 1958(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Board of Trade hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duty Drawbacks (No. 5) Order 1970.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) This Order shall come into operation on 3rd September 1970.

2. In Schedule 2 to the Import Duty Drawbacks (No. 10) Order of 1968(c) (which relates to the drawbacks to be allowed on the exportation of goods produced or manufactured from imported articles), in the entry relating to apricot kernel products, in column 3, for “18s. 2d. per cwt.” there shall be substituted “£1 3s. 0d. per cwt.”.
