The Awards (First Degree, etc. Courses) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1970

Made 25th August 1970 Laid before Parliament 28th August 1970 Coming into Operation 1st September 1970

The Secretary of State for Education and Science, in exercise of the powers conferred upon her by sections 1 and 4 of the Education Act 1962(a) as amended by the Secretary of State for Education and Science Order 1964(b), hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Awards (First Degree, etc. Courses) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1970 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1970.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of Regulations

- 2. The Awards (First Degree, etc. Courses) Regulations 1970(d) as amended (e) shall have effect subject to-
 - (a) in regulation 21(b) (assisted students), the substitution for the word 'receives" of the words "there is paid to or in respect of him";
 - (b) in paragraph 2 of schedule 2 (parental contribution), in the definition of "child", the substitution for the words "paragraph 4(2)" of the words 'paragraphs 4(2) and 6(12)"; and
 - (c) in paragraph 6(12) of that schedule the insertion after the word "child" of the words "who holds a statutory award".
