The Personal Injuries (Civilians) (Amendment) Scheme 1970

The Secretary of State for Social Services, with the consent of the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 2 of the Personal Injuries (Emergency Provisions) Act 1939(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme :—

Citation, interpretation and commencement

1. This Scheme, which may be cited as the Personal Injuries (Civilians) (Amendment) Scheme 1970, amends the Personal Injuries (Civilians) Scheme 1964(b), as amended (c), (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Scheme”), and the Personal Injuries (Civilians) (Amendment) Scheme 1969(d) (hereinafter referred to as “the 1969 Scheme”), and shall come into operation on 12th February 1970.

Definitions

2. In this Scheme—

- (1) “the appointed day” means 15th February 1971 (the day appointed under section 1 of the Decimal Currency Act 1967(e));
- (2) “the new currency” means the new currency of the United Kingdom provided for by the Decimal Currency Act 1967.

Higher maximum rate of allowance for part-time treatment

3.—(1) In Schedule 3 to the principal Scheme, for paragraph 11 (part-time treatment allowance under Article 23) there shall be substituted the paragraph set out in Part I of the Schedule hereto.

(2) In Part II of the Schedule to the 1969 Scheme (Schedules in the new currency to be substituted in the principal Scheme on the appointed day) for paragraph 11 of Schedule 3 (part-time treatment allowance under Article 23) there shall be substituted the paragraph set out in Part II of the Schedule hereto.

PART I

Paragraph to be substituted in Schedule 3 to the principal Scheme

"11. Part-time treatment allowance under Article 23 80s. per day
(maximum)"

PART II

Paragraph to be substituted in Schedule 3 in Part II of the Schedule to the 1969 Scheme

"11. Part-time treatment allowance under Article 23 £4 per day
(maximum)"

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Scheme.)

This Scheme increases the maximum rate of the allowance payable under the Personal Injuries (Civilians) Scheme 1964 to certain persons having regard to any remunerative time lost as a result of receiving part-time treatment for their pensioned disablement.
