**The Merchant Shipping Load Line Convention (Guernsey)
Order 1970**

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in pursuance of the power conferred on Her by section 64 of the Merchant Shipping (Safety and Load Line Conventions) Act 1932^(a), as read with section 74 of that Act and with section 738(1) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1894^(b), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Merchant Shipping Load Line Convention (Guernsey) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1970.

2. In Part II of the Schedule to the Merchant Shipping Load Line Convention (Guernsey) Order 1933^(c) (which sets out adaptations and modifications in the extension of the Merchant Shipping (Safety and Load Line Conventions) Act 1932 to the Bailiwick of Guernsey)—

- (a) in the second paragraph (modification of section 48(5)) for the words “the States Supervisor” there shall be substituted the words “the States Board of Administration” ;
- (b) in the third paragraph (substituting a new section 53(5)) for the proviso there shall be substituted the following words :—

“Provided that where the ship has been detained under either of the last-mentioned sections the States Board of Administration shall order the ship to be released as soon as they are satisfied that the ship is fit to proceed to sea without danger to human life.” ;
- (c) in the fifth paragraph (modifying section 57(a)) for the words “the States Supervisor” there shall be substituted the words “the States Board of Administration”.

3. In Article 2 of the Merchant Shipping Load Line Convention (Guernsey) (Amendment) Order 1958(a) (which sets out additional adaptations and modifications in the said extension by amendment of the said Part II) for the words "by the States Supervisor or a person duly authorised in that behalf by the States Supervisor" there shall be substituted the words "by a person duly authorised in that behalf by the States Board of Administration".
