PUNISHMENT WITHOUT PROSECUTION

The Fixed Penalty (Areas) (Scotland) (No. 3) Order 1970

Made - - - 22nd October 1970

Laid before Parliament 5th November 1970

Coming into Operation 1st December 1970

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 80 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967^(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Fixed Penalty (Areas) (Scotland) (No. 3) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1970.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889^(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. Section 80 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by section 131(1) of the Transport Act 1968^(c) (which relates to the fixed penalty procedure) shall extend to the whole of Scotland.

4.—(1) The Fixed Penalty (Areas) (Scotland) (No. 2) Order 1970^(d) is hereby revoked.

(2) Section 38 of the Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply as if this order were an Act of Parliament and as if the order revoked by this order were an Act of Parliament repealed by an Act of Parliament.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Section 80 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended and extended by section 131(1) of the Transport Act 1968 provides for the discharge of liability to conviction of certain traffic offences by the payment of a fixed penalty. The section extends only to such areas as the Secretary of State may by order specify. This Order extends the operation of the section to the whole of Scotland and revokes a previous Order extending the section to particular areas.
