**The Industrial Training (Furniture and Timber Industry Board)
Order 1969 (Amendment) Order 1970**

The Secretary of State after consultation with the Furniture and Timber Industry Training Board and with organisations and associations of organisations appearing to be representative respectively of substantial numbers of employers engaging in the activities hereinafter mentioned and of substantial numbers of persons employed in those activities and in exercise of his powers under section 9 of the Industrial Training Act 1964(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following Order :—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Industrial Training (Furniture and Timber Industry Board) Order 1969 (Amendment) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 18th November 1970.

(2) In this Order—

- (a) “the Act” means the Industrial Training Act 1964 ;
- (b) “the Board” means the Furniture and Timber Industry Training Board;
- (c) “Levy Order” includes the Industrial Training Levy (Furniture and Timber) Order 1966(b), the Industrial Training Levy (Furniture and Timber) Order 1968(c), the Industrial Training Levy (Furniture and Timber) Order 1969(d) and the Industrial Training Levy (Furniture and Timber) Order 1970(e) ;
- (d) “the 1969 Order” means the Industrial Training (Furniture and Timber Industry Board) Order 1969(f) ;
- (e) “the principal Order” means the Industrial Training (Furniture and Timber Industry Board) Order 1965(g).

(3) The Interpretation Act 1889(h) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if this Order, the principal Order and the 1969 Order were Acts of Parliament.

Amendment of the 1969 Order

2. The 1969 Order (which substituted the Schedule to that Order for Schedule 1 to the principal Order) shall be amended in accordance with the Schedule to this Order, and accordingly the activities in relation to which the Board exercises the functions conferred by the Act upon industrial training boards shall, in lieu of the activities specified in the Schedule to the 1969 Order, be the activities specified in that Schedule as amended by the Schedule to this Order.

Transitional provisions

3.—(1) The chairman and other members of the Board on the day upon which this Order comes into operation shall continue to be members of the Board and to hold and vacate their offices in accordance with the terms of the instruments appointing them to be members.

(2) The provisions of this Order shall not—

- (a) extend the operation of a Levy Order ;
- (b) affect the operation of a Levy Order in relation to the assessment of an employer within the meaning of that Order in respect of an establishment that was engaged in the relevant levy period wholly or mainly in activities included in the Schedule to the 1969 Order as amended by the Schedule to this Order ;
- (c) affect the operation of any assessment notice served by the Board under the provisions of a Levy Order before the date upon which this Order comes into operation or any appeal or other proceedings arising out of any such notice.

Article 2

SCHEDULE**Amendments to the 1969 Order**

1. In this Schedule the expression “the Schedule” means the Schedule to the 1969 Order.

2. In paragraph 1 of the Schedule immediately after sub-paragraph (g) there shall be inserted the following sub-paragraph—

“(ga) the manufacture, fitting out or repair of caravans;”.

3.—(1) Paragraph 2 of the Schedule shall be amended as follows.

(2) In item 7 of the Table to sub-paragraph (c) for the words “Vehicle bodies” in the third column there shall be substituted the words “Vehicle bodies (not being bodies for caravans)”.

(3) In sub-paragraph (d)(ii) the words “in agriculture or horticulture or” shall be omitted.

(4) In sub-paragraph (d)(vi) for the words “as shipping and forwarding agents” there shall be substituted the words “as freight forwarders”.

(5) In sub-paragraph (e) the word “or” shall be inserted at the end of head (vi) and a further head shall be added as follows—

“(vii) a charity;”.

(6) Immediately after sub-paragraph (g) there shall be inserted the following sub-paragraph—

“(ga) any activities in agriculture;”.

4.—(1) Paragraph 3 shall be amended as follows.

(2) For the definition of “agriculture or horticulture” there shall be substituted the following—

“‘agriculture’ has the same meaning as in section 109(3) of the Agriculture Act 1947(a) or, in relation to Scotland, as in section 86(3) of the Agriculture (Scotland) Act 1948(b);”.

(3) Immediately after the definition of “building or civil engineering work” there shall be inserted the following—

“‘caravan’ means a vehicle (not being a motor vehicle or railway rolling stock) which is designed for use, by one or more persons, as accommodation for living or business purposes;”.

(4) Immediately after the definition of “carpets and other floor coverings” there shall be inserted the following—

“‘charity’ has the same meaning as in section 360 of the Income and Corporation Taxes Act 1970(c);”.

(5) In the definition of “vehicle bodies” the words “and bodies for caravans” shall be omitted.

(6) For the definition of “wood” there shall be substituted the following—

“‘wood’ means wood of any kind (other than firewood or kindling wood) whether it is in the rough or has undergone any conversion or preparation but does not include—

- (a) bark;
- (b) cork;
- (c) paper or paperboard;
- (d) wood pulp or wood wool;
- (e) sawdust, wood chips, wood flour, wood shavings or other ligneous waste; or
- (f) charcoal.”.

5.—(1) In the Appendix to the Schedule the following entries shall be substituted for the corresponding entries appearing in that Appendix—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Schedule to the Industrial Training (Furniture and Timber Industry Board) Order 1969 which specifies the activities in relation to which the Furniture and Timber Industry Training Board exercises its functions.

The principal changes are the inclusion in the furniture and timber industry of the manufacture, fitting out or repair of caravans and the exclusion from that industry of the activities of a charity.
