CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Anti-Dumping Duty (No. 4) Order 1970

Made - - - - - 3rd November 1970
Laid before the
House of Commons 6th November 1970
Coming into Operation 10th November 1970

Whereas by the Anti-Dumping (Provisional Charge to Duty) (No. 5) Order 1970(a), which came into operation on 24th June 1970, goods of the description set out in the Schedule hereto were made subject to a provisional charge to duty in respect of a duty of customs at the rate of 10s. per cwt. in respect of an anti-dumping duty :

And whereas the said Order remains in force(b) :

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under sections 1, 2, 8, 9(3) and 15(4) of the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1969(c) hereby makes the following Order :—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Anti-Dumping Duty (No. 4) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 10th November 1970.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if this Order and the Orders hereby revoked were Acts of Parliament.

2. There shall be charged on the import into the United Kingdom on a date not earlier than 24th June 1970 nor later than 30th June 1970 of any goods of the description set out in the Schedule hereto (being goods classified in the Customs Tariff 1959(e) under the heading mentioned in the first column of that Schedule) a duty of customs at the rate mentioned in the third column.

3. Section 2 of the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1969 (which allows relief to be given where goods are shown not to have been dumped or where the margin of dumping is less than the amount of the duty) shall apply to the duty imposed by this Order.

4. The Anti-Dumping (Provisional Charge to Duty) (No. 5) Order 1970 and the Anti-Dumping (Provisional Charge to Duty) (No. 5) (Extension) Order 1970(f) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order imposes an anti-dumping duty of 10s. per cwt. on French new potatoes. The duty is imposed retrospectively in relation to a period beginning on the 24th June 1970 when such goods became subject to a provisional charge to duty of 10s. per cwt. by virtue of the Anti-Dumping (Provisional Charge to Duty) (No. 5) Order 1970 and ending with 30th June 1970 after which date the import of such potatoes was restricted by the Importation of Potatoes (Health) (Great Britain) Order 1964 (S.I. 1964/409), as amended.

The Order applies to the duty section 2 of the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1969, which enables relief to be granted where particular goods have not been dumped or the margin of dumping is less than the amount of the duty.
