**CUSTOMS AND EXCISE**

**The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment) Order 1970**

*Made - - - - 4th February 1970*

*Coming into Operation 18th February 1970*

The Board of Trade, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939<sup>(a)</sup>, hereby order as follows:—

**1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment) Order 1970 and shall come into operation on 18th February 1970.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889<sup>(b)</sup> shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

**2.** The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1967<sup>(c)</sup>, as amended<sup>(d)</sup>, shall have effect as if—

(i) there were added as paragraph (l) of Article 2(1) the following:—

“ (l) pork to any port or destination in the Republic of Ireland ” ;  
and

(ii) the following entry were included in Schedule 1, Part I, Group 8, namely—

“ Pork, fresh, chilled or frozen (excluding offals) ... .. A ”.

This Order further amends the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1967 by including pork among the goods of which the export is controlled. An exception is made in relation to export to the Republic of Ireland.
