WEIGHTS AND MEASURES

The Weights and Measures (Amendment) Regulations 1970

Made - - - - 13th November 1970 Laid before Parliament 19th November 1970 Coming into Operation 20th November 1970

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under sections 11(3), 14(1) and 58 of the Weights and Measures Act 1963(a) and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Weights and Measures (Amendment) Regulations 1970 and shall come into operation on 20th November 1970.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The Weights and Measures Regulations 1963(c), as amended(d), shall have effect subject to the amendments set out in paragraphs 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto.

- 2. The limits of error as respects the obliteration of stamps shall be four times the relevant limits specified in the foregoing Table.".
- 3. Paragraph 2 of Part II of Schedule 1 shall have effect as if for the tables in sub-paragraphs (a) and (c) there were substituted the tables set out below, and from 1st January 1971, as if sub-paragraph (b) were omitted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Weights and Measures Regulations 1963 (S.I. 1963/1710).

The principal changes are that limits of error are prescribed for certain new metric measures the use of which is made lawful by the Weights and Measures Act 1963 (Amendment of Schedules 1 and 3) Order 1970 (S.I. 1970/1709) and that uniform limits of error are now prescribed for all measures of the same length irrespective of the material or form of the measure.
